Make Sure You are a Member in Good Standing

We would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone that we are no longer allowed to take payroll deduction for your dues payments. If you have not signed up with one of the methods listed below you are no longer a member in good standing. Please note we must receive monthly payment for you to remain a member in good standing. You must ensure you give us the correct account information and have sufficient funds in you account.

- ⇒ Contact your WVSSPA staff Representative or call our office (304-346-3544) for a ACH Dues Payment form (Automatic Withdrawal using a checking or savings account) to fill out and mail back to the WVSSPA office. Deduction day will be the 25th or next business day each month.
- ⇒ Pay online at www.wvsspa.org with ACH (Automatic Withdrawal using a checking or savings account). Deduction day will be the 25th or next business day each month.
- ⇒ Pay online at www.wvsspa.org with a credit or debit card. The day you sign up will become your deduction day. For example, if you sign up on November 15 your deduction day going forward will be the 15th of every month.
- ⇒ Pay Cash/Check/Money order for the full year's dues amount. This must be accompanied by an application.

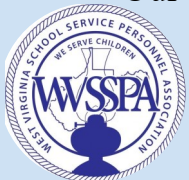
